SAFETY OBJECTIVES

Safety is AFCO's first priority.

AFCO management is firmly committed to a policy enabling all work activities to be carried out safely.

With all possible measures taken to remove (or at least reduce) risks to the health, safety and welfare of workers, contractors, authorised visitors, and anyone else who may be affected by our operations.

We are committed to ensuring we comply with the Work Health and Safety Act 2011, the Work Health and Safety Regulations 2017 and applicable Codes of Practice and Australian Standards as far as possible.

We firmly believe that safety management is critical for the successful completion of any project. Hence, we promote a risk based management system, and a safety culture that encourages people to proactively manage health and safety risk through education, instruction, information and supervision.

AFCO clearly defines and communicates with the staff, contractors and visitors its responsibilities in relation to health and safety. Our team understands and adopts the safety values of the project and can comply with the safety policies and procedure requirements.

Our staff hold extensive qualifications including working at heights, confined space training, first aid and CPR, white cards, Welding certificates and equipment tickets. Their extensive training ensures they have the knowledge and skill to be safe.

Principally, our culture mandates that everyone, irrespective of their role, must obey with the followings Mandatory Safety Rules with no tolerance:

- always verify and tag or lock all energy isolations
- + never remove another person's danger tag or personal lock without written authorisation
- always operate equipment and machinery within defined safety limits

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- never begin a skilled task or operate equipment and machinery unless qualified
- 4 always obtain authorisation before entering a confined space
- never disable or override a safety device without written authorisation
- 4 always protect against falling where you can fall more than 2 metres
- never work or travel under a suspended load
- 🜲 always wear seatbelts when a vehicle is in motion
- never consume or be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs while at work

We will achieve this by ensuring that,

- A. AFCO's Management providing and maintaining as far as possible:
 - A safe working environment.
 - Safe systems of work.
 - Plant and substances in a safe condition.
 - Facilities for the welfare of workers.
 - Information, instruction, training and supervision that is reasonable.
 - Necessary to ensure that each worker is safe from injury and risks to health.
 - A commitment to consult and co-operate with workers in all matters relating to health and safety in the workplace.
 - A commitment to continually improve our performance through effective safety management.

- B. Each worker has an obligation to:
 - Comply with safe work practices, with the intent of avoiding injury to themselves and others and damage to plant and equipment.
 - Take reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others.
 - Wear personal protective equipment and clothing where necessary.
 - Comply with any direction given by management for health and safety.
 - Not misuse or interfere with anything provided for health and safety.
 - Report all accidents and incidents on the job immediately, no matter how trivial.
 - Report all known or observed hazards to their supervisor or manager.
